

CHAPTER 1

PLUMBING REGULATIONS

4-1-1: State Plumbing Code Adopted

4-1-2: Plumber's Bond

4-1-1: STATE PLUMBING CODE ADOPTED: The Illinois State Plumbing Code published by the Illinois Department of Public Health, and all amendments thereto, are hereby adopted for reference and made a part of this Chapter. Three (3) copies of the Illinois State Plumbing Code shall be kept on file in the office of the Village Clerk for public inspection. Any person who violates any provision of the State Plumbing Code shall be subject to the penalties provided for violation of this Code. (1963 Code, 15.01)

4-1-2: PLUMBER'S BOND: No licensed plumber shall make any connection with the Village sewer system or make any excavation in any street or alley for any purpose, unless the plumber shall have executed to the Village a good and sufficient bond in the penal sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) with sureties to be approved by the President and Board of Trustees, conditioned for the faithful observance of all the requirements of this Code regulating plumbing and sewers and conditioned to indemnify, save and keep harmless the Village from any loss, cost, damage, expense or liability of any kind which the Village may suffer, or which may accrue against it, be charged to or recovered from the Village from or by reason of anything done by such licensed plumber in connection with any drain or pipe or connections with the sewer system of the Village, or which may arise from or by reason of any negligence on the part of such licensed plumber in not maintaining barriers and warning signals around any excavation or opening which has been made by him in any street, alley or public way within the Village, and conditioned further to restore the surface of any street, sidewalk or roadway wherever the same shall have been disturbed by him in and about the doing of any work, and conditioned further, to do such work of restoration to the satisfaction and approval of the Street Commissioner within two (2) weeks after its disturbance, weather permitting, otherwise such work will be done by the Village and the charge assessed to the plumber. No permit shall be issued to any plumber to do any work requiring the disturbance of any street, alley or public way or the alteration, repair or location of any drain pipe or connection with the sewer system of the Village unless such bond is in full force and on file in the office of the Clerk.
