

CHAPTER 4
EXCAVATIONS

SECTION:

- 8-4-1: Permit Required
- 8-4-2: Bond or Insurance
- 8-4-3: Deposit
- 8-4-4: Duty to Repair

8-4-1: PERMIT REQUIRED: No person shall make any excavation in or tunnel under any street, parkway, alley or sidewalk or other public places in the Village without first having secured a permit therefor. Applications for such permits shall be made to the Clerk and shall specify the intended location and purpose of the excavation. Any person making any such excavation shall refill the same properly and shall restore the surface to its condition before the excavation as soon as possible. All excavations, refills and resurfacing shall be made subject to the supervision and direction of the Street Commissioner.

8-4-2: BOND OR INSURANCE: No such permit shall be issued unless there shall be filed with the Clerk evidence of a public liability insurance policy or bond, in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00), conditioned to indemnify the Village and hold it harmless against any claim for injury, liability or damages caused by the making of such excavation or tunnel or the existence thereof. If a blanket public liability insurance policy has been secured by the Village to protect against risks incurred by such work, then no bond shall be required of the person making the excavation.

8-4-3: PERMIT FEE: No such permit shall be issued unless the applicant has paid the Village Clerk a fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).

8-4-4: DUTY TO REPAIR: The applicant shall restore the street to its original condition within thirty (30) calendar days from the time work commenced. If it is not restored to its original condition within the thirty (30) days the Village may proceed to restore the street and the applicant shall reimburse the Village the costs, fees and expense of the time, materials and 10% for the administration of the excavation.
